## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE Issued with a 14-day comment period

## **Description of Proposal:**

This threshold determination analyzes the environmental impacts associated with the following actions, which are so closely related to each other that they are in effect a single course of action:

- 1. The adoption of Central Kitsap School District 2023-2028 Capital Facilities Plan by the Central Kitsap School District #401 for the purposes of planning for the facilities needs of the District; and
- 2. The amendment of the Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan to include the Central Kitsap School District's 2023-2028 Capital Facilities Plan as part of the Capital Facilities Element of the County's Comprehensive Plan. The city of Bremerton may also amend their Comprehensive Plan to include the Central Kitsap School District's Capital Facilities Plan as part of the Capital Facilities Element of their Comprehensive Plan.

**Proponent:** Central Kitsap School District #401

## **Location of Proposal:**

The Central Kitsap School District includes an area of approximately 117 square miles. Parts of unincorporated Kitsap County fall within the district's boundaries.

Lead Agency: Central Kitsap School District #401

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that the proposal does not have a probable significant adverse environmental impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after a review of the completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency and in compliance with Central Kitsap School District Policy 6890. This Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issue. The responsible official will reconsider the DNS based on timely comments and may retain, modify, or, if significant adverse impacts are likely, withdraw the DNS. If the DNS is retained, it will be final after the expiration of the comment deadline.
